



Circulation of fake news regarding Tesco stores

KUALA LUMPUR, 18 March 2020: In addressing the information being circulated on social media and text messaging, Tesco Stores (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd would like to assure customers that there have not been any reported or confirmed cases of Covid-19 in any of our stores. The allegations that Covid-19 has been detected in **Tesco Tanjung Pinang** and **Tesco Bukit Beruntung (colloquially known as Tesco Bukit Sentosa)**, respectively, are baseless and false.

We ask that customers exercise good judgment when receiving such information and when in doubt, please check against the Ministry of Health website or Facebook page as well as Tesco's website and Facebook page for clarification.

Tesco continues to work closely with the health authorities and the management of all our 60 stores nationwide to undertake all necessary measures to ensure the health and safety of our colleagues and customers. These measures include regularly disinfecting our trolleys, check-out counters and every other area that has high customer exposure such as toilets and food courts.
