



## **TESCO DISINFECTS STORE AFTER EMPLOYEE TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID19**

**KULAI, 28 MARCH 2020:** Tesco Stores (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd today confirmed that an employee at its Tesco Kulai store has tested positive for Covid-19. The employee who has been in quarantine at home since 24 March 2020 has shown mild symptoms and is currently being monitored by the local health authorities.

Tesco is working with the Ministry of Health to ensure the health and safety of its colleagues who may have been in close contact.

In the meantime, Tesco is taking proactive measures of temporarily closing the store on 28 March 2020 to be disinfected and deep cleaned as a precaution. The store will reopen on 30 March 2020.

In safeguarding its colleagues' and customers' health and safety, the hypermarket has provided masks for all their employees as well as conducting temperature checks for all its employees and customer daily. Tesco also encourages customers to continue taking preventive measures such as practicing good handwashing hygiene and social distancing while at stores to further prevent the spread of infections.
